Please note a change below to the **TANK** information during Spirit of America on Fri. 9/17 & 9/18 at the Bank of Kentucky Center.

Also as a reminder:

The Bank of Kentucky is hosting Spirit of America, a community outreach event produced by the US Army. On Friday, September 17th, traffic on campus will be adversely affected. Given such, please be aware of the following:

Lots:

Lot O & the Welcome Center Garage will be closed all day to all NKU faculty, staff, & students. Please park instead at all other available parking areas where your permit is valid. There will be plenty of parking spaces available in Lots K, L, P, Y, A and Kenton Garage.

Entrance onto campus:

- Martha Layne Collins will not be an available access point onto campus from approximately 8:30am – 2pm.
- Entrance from the 3-Mile exit will be accessible onto campus but will be detoured onto Kenton Drive.
- Entrance via Nunn Drive will remain accessible.

Campus Road Closures

University Drive will be closed between John Hills & Nunn Drive periodically between 9am – 2pm.

Exit off of campus:

Anyone leaving campus that needs to access I-275 or I-471 between 12pm – 2pm should utilize the John Hills Road to AA Highway to get to those respective freeways.

TANK

Bus route #25 WILL NOT be affected. The NKU Shuttle will not stop at the BEP building, but will instead stop at the loading dock behind the Student Union. The #11 will not stop on campus on 9/17 or 9/18. The closest #11 stop will be in front of Callahan Hall. There will be postings on the affected stops themselves.

Please expect delays and allow plenty of time this day in getting to campus on-time.
